
PLEASE FOLLOW THIS PROCEDURE

This will assure your backflow preventer does not freeze, incurring costly repair.

- Turn off the main shut-off valve in basement (A) which provides water to the system.
- 2. Open all inlet and outlet drain valves on the system (B and E).
- Open inlet and outlet shut-off valves on backflow prevention assembly (C and D) and all testcocks. Leave in half open / half closed (45° angle) position to allow for full drainage of ball valve shut-offs.
- Open the two (2) testcocks on the side of the backflow preventer (F). Note: New style is screw head type.
